

Ecological Solutions and Evidence (ESE) is an open access journal at the heart of AER.

It publishes a unique suite of article types such as Practice Insights and Registered Reports that promote open science and provide a platform for practitioners to communicate with a broad audience.

Authors are encouraged to archive any reports or technical documents associated with their article in AER for long-term preservation and discovery.

Set custom alerts – create a free profile to select your topics of interest and be notified when new documents are available on the platform.

Search using custom filters – easily search by topic, location, organism, language or any keyword.

Sign up to the newsletter – stay up to date on our Members' works, key events, opportunities, and additional resources from across the sector.
